



During the AlpCity project two different parallel initiatives were carried out by the team:

1. the school exchange between Grainau and Turin
2. "Amelie au bureau"

## 1. THE SCHOOL EXCHANGE

In the framework of the AlpCity Project, the AlpCity team supported the proposal of the Partner Gemeinde Grainau of coordinating an exchange between two classrooms of young students (eight years old) coming from the Municipality of Grainau (Germany) and from the Convitto Umberto I of Turin (Italy).

From the 3<sup>rd</sup> until the 8<sup>th</sup> of July 2006, 33 German students of the fourth class of the Grainau Primary School went to Turin and stayed for a week with Italian students of the same age.

During the week a day for socializing, a welcome party with the Convitto Chancellor, the visit to the Olympic sites, the Medieval Burgh of the Valentino Castle, the Royal Palace and Fiat Mirafiori were organised.

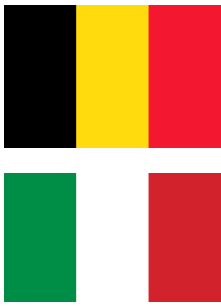
German students also received some gadgets offered by the Fiat (key rings and car models) and the Toroc - **Turin OR**ganising **C**ommittee for the XX Olympic Games - (gadgets of the Olympic Games – balls, posters and DVDs).

This experience had important results for AlpCity: as AlpCity carried out a transnational project aiming at exchanging innovative experiences among nations and regions as this school-exchange represents an important step towards an intense activity of exchanges among the youngest in order to compare different lands, cultures and languages.

Italian children will be hosted by the Community of Grainau in February 2007. It's a sure thing this exchange had a great success so that it would be possible to repeat these type of experience in the framework of transnational projects which can place its contacts at these purposes disposal.

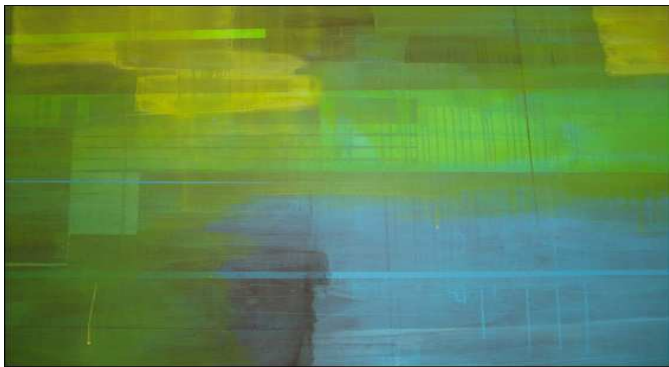
## 2. AMELIE AU BUREAU
